Per ORS 204.016, person must be "an elector under the Oregon Constitution"

County Commissioner	18	Resident of county one year prior to election.	4 years	This is a nonpartisan position with the passage of Measure 18-90.	County governing body appoints qualified person until successor is elected.
<p><i>This office can be won at the Primary Election if; only one (1) candidate files for this office in the Primary or two (2) or more candidates file for this office and one (1) receives the majority of votes. (50%+1)</i></p> <p><i>A candidate will be nominated at the Primary Election and go forward to the General Election if; two (2) or more candidates file for this office and no one receives the majority of the votes at the Primary. The top two (2) vote getters are then nominated to go forward to the General Election.</i></p>					

Surveyor	18	Resident of county one year prior to election.	4 years	Registered professional land surveyor.	County governing body appoints qualified person until successor is elected.
<p><i>This office can be won at the Primary Election if; only one (1) candidate files for this office in the Primary or two (2) or more candidates file for this office and one (1) receives the majority of votes. (50%+1)</i></p> <p><i>A candidate will be nominated at the Primary Election and go forward to the General Election if; two (2) or more candidates file for this office and no one receives the majority of the votes at the Primary. The top two (2) vote getters are then nominated to go forward to the General Election.</i></p>					

Sheriff	21	Resident of county one year prior to election.	4 years	Proof of certification or eligibility for certification by Department of Public Safety Standards and Training must be provided to filing officer no later than 61 days prior to the election.	County governing body appoints qualified person until successor is elected.
<p><i>If 1 or 2 candidate(s) file they are both considered nominated and go forward to the General Election and their name(s) will be printed on the General Election ballot. The candidate(s) name(s) will not appear on the Primary Election ballot.</i></p> <p><i>If three (3) or more candidates file, their names will be printed on the Primary Election ballot. If one (1) candidate receives the majority of votes that candidate is nominated and his/her name will be printed on the General Election ballot. If no candidate receives the majority of votes the top two (2) vote getters will go forward to the General Election and their names will be printed on the General Election ballot.</i></p>
