GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS

Shall Klamath County Fire District No. 1 replace aged and worn emergency response vehicles by issuing \$1,985,000 in bonds? If the bonds are approved, they will be payable from taxes on property or property ownership that are not subject to the limits of sections 11 and 11b, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Summary 175 words which concisely and impartially summarizes the measure and its major effect

If approved, this measure will finance capital costs of replacing aged and worn emergency response vehicles and equipment, including:

- Purchase and equip five (5) fire engines;
- Purchase and equip five (5) ambulances;
- Purchase and equip one (1) command vehicle;
- Pay the costs associated with the bond issuance.

Bonds would mature in a period not to exceed five and one half (5 1/2) years from the date of issue and may be issued in one or more series. The measure is estimated to cost taxpayers an average of \$0.16 per \$1,000 of assessed value each year. For the owner of a home or property owner, the estimated annual average cost would be \$16 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value, annually.

The estimated tax cost for this measure is an ESTIMATE ONLY, based on the best information available from the county assessor at the time of the estimate. Results may differ, based upon actual growth in assessed value and collection rate for Klamath County.
