SECONDHAND DEALERS

**602.500 Penalty.**

(1) Whoever violates or fails to comply with any of the provisions of this Chapter shall be fined not more than [~~five~~] six hundred dollars (\$~~500~~] 600) for a first offense.

(2) For a second offense, a person shall be fined not more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000).

(3) For a subsequent offense, a person shall be fined not more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000).

CHAPTER 603  
TRANSIENT ROOM TAX

**603.800 Violations.** It is unlawful for any operator or other person so required to fail or refuse to register as required herein, or to furnish any return required to be made, or fail or refuse to furnish a supplemental return or other data required by the Tax Administrator or to render a false or fraudulent return. No person required to make, render, sign, or verify any report shall make any false or fraudulent report with intent to defeat or evade the determination of any amount due required by this Chapter. Any person willfully violating any of the provisions of this Chapter shall be subject to a fine of not more than [~~Two Fifty]~~ three hundred [~~D~~] dollars (\$~~250~~] 300.00).



**800.920 Severability.** The provisions of this Chapter are severable. If a portion of this Chapter is for any reason held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Chapter.
