Under state law, a city council may adopt an ordinance to be referred to voters of the city imposing up to a three percent tax on the sale of marijuana items in the city by a licensed marijuana retailer.

Approval of this measure would impose a three percent tax on the sale of marijuana items in the city of Chiloquin by a licensed marijuana retailer. The tax would be collected at the point of sale and remitted by the marijuana retailer.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Approval of this measure would impose a three percent tax on the sale of marijuana items by a marijuana retailer within the City of Chiloquin. If approved, the revenues from this tax are currently unknown. There are no restrictions on how the city may use the revenues generated by this tax.

Under Oregon law, the Oregon Liquor Control Commission must license the retail sale of recreational marijuana ORS 475B.491 provides that a city council may adopt an ordinance imposing up to a three percent tax on the sale of marijuana items (which include marijuana concentrates, extracts, edibles, and other products intended for human consumption and use) by retail licensees in the city, but the council must refer that ordinance to the voters at a statewide general election. The Chiloquin City Council has adopted an ordinance imposing a three percent tax on the sale of marijuana items by a retail licensee in the City, and, as a result, has referred this measure to the voters.
