Dear Klamath County Planning Board and Commissioners,

I am writing to you to express my concerns with the South Suburban District's (SSSD) plan to apply Class B Biosolids to the Reeder and North Poe Valley sites.

- The smell of the biosolids will be prevalent in our neighborhoods. The aerosolizations will cause health problems for us, our children, and our animals.
- If the wells on the properties where the biosolids will be applied are not properly sealed and monitored, contamination will leach into our water table and eventually into our private wells. This will contaminate our water sources.
- Applying the biosolids to the land will cause disruptions and safety concerns in our neighborhoods due to the new truck traffic to deliver the biosolids.
- It is not heard of to apply both recycled water and biosolids to the same land as it will destroy the soil due to high levels of nutrients, pathogens and contaminants.
- Property values will decrease due to the smell, new traffic, and safety concerns of potential buyers!!!
- There are many alternatives to this project that have not been considered, nor evaluated by the SSSD.

Because of these reasons and more, I do not approve of the SSSD's Class B Biosolids project and it needs to be stopped.
